

"FIESTA" STOCK HORSE RULES

Division • Definitions • Rules

GENERAL

The pattern will be determined by the judge. Divisions are based on the rider's age and ability, not the age or ability of the horse.

OPEN STOCK HORSE

Anyone may compete in the Open division, including professional riders and trainers. The rider will complete the designated reining pattern, box the cow, take the cow down the fence, and then have the option of either circling or roping the cow.

Pattern: Pattern 11

NOVICE STOCK HORSE

Only competitors who have not trained horses for money, accepted payment for riding, or made a living from riding in the last 5 years, and who have not won more than \$500 in prize money as a rider, are eligible to compete in the Novice Stock Horse division. The rider will complete the designated reining pattern, then box the cow, take it down the fence, and box it again at the opposite end of the arena.

Pattern: Pattern 6

YOUTH STOCK HORSE

The Youth division is open to riders under 18 years of age. The rider will complete the designated reining pattern, then box the cow at one end of the arena for 1 minute.

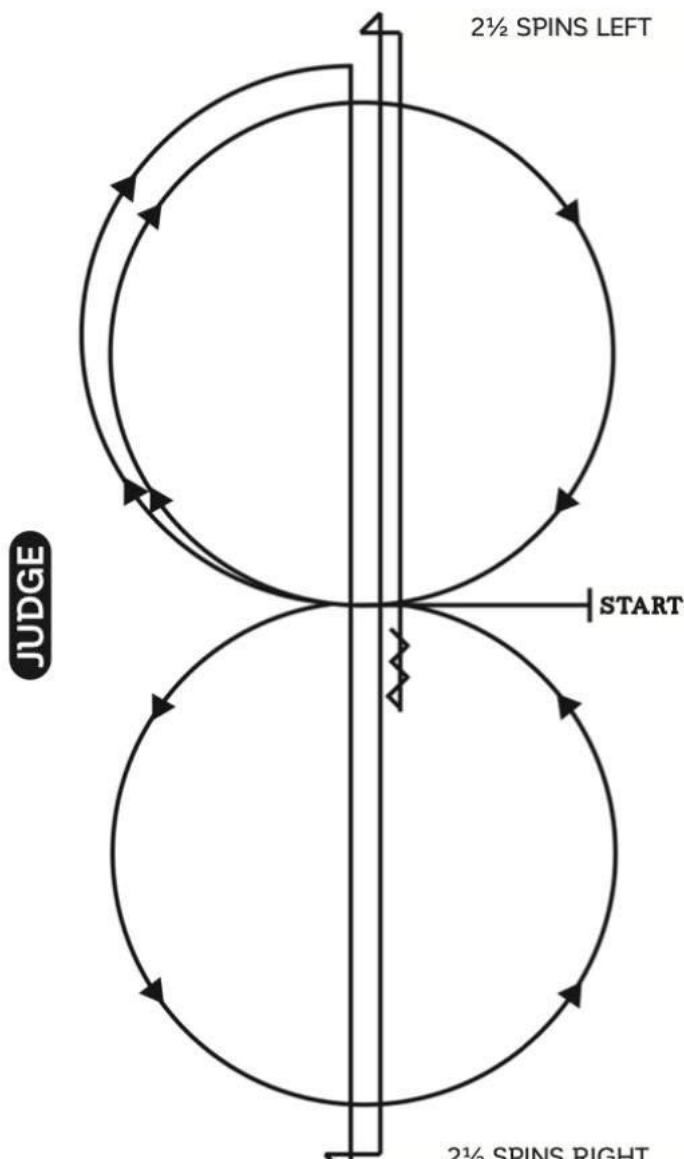
Pattern: Pattern 6

Division	Pattern	Cow Work
Open	Pattern 11	Box, fence, then circle or rope
Novice	Pattern 6	Box, fence, then box opposite end
Youth	Pattern 6	Box at one end for 1 minute

NOVICE & YOUTH STOCK HORSE

PATTERN 6

Novice and Youth riders use Pattern 6. Fiesta cow-work requirements are listed on page 1.



- Trot to center of arena, stop. Start pattern facing towards judge

1. Beginning on the right lead lope one circle to the right. Change leads to the left.
2. Complete one circle to the left. Change leads to the right and go to the top of the arena.
3. Run down center of arena past the end marker and come to a sliding stop.
4. Complete 2½ spins to the right.
5. Run to the other end of the arena, past the end marker and come to a sliding stop.
6. Complete 2½ spins to the left.
7. Run past the center marker, stop and back at least 10 feet.

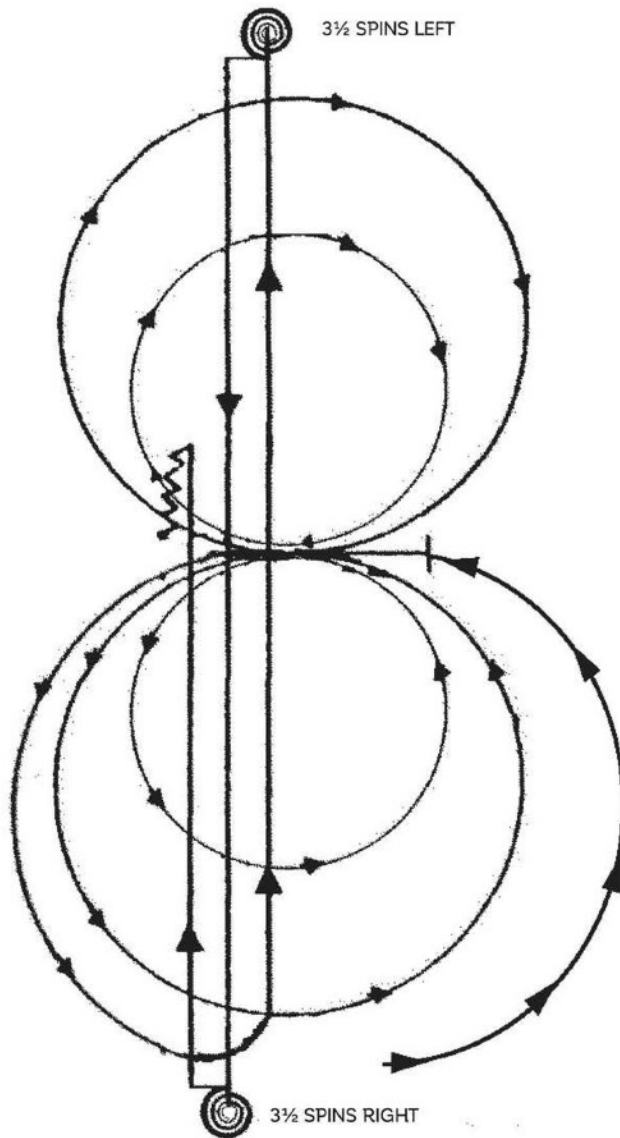
*This pattern may be used as a lope in pattern, please refer to rule 20.6.

OPEN STOCK HORSE

PATTERN 11

Open riders use Pattern 11 . Fiesta cow-work requirements are listed on page 1.

JUDGE



Begin on left lead. At the center, without stopping or breaking gait, begin pattern facing toward the judge. Refer to rule 20.6.

1. Beginning on the left lead complete two circles to the left, the first circle large and fast, and the second circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
2. Complete two circles to the right, the first large and fast, the second small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
3. Continue around end of arena without breaking gait or changing leads, run down center of the arena past the end marker, execute a square sliding stop.
4. Complete $3\frac{1}{2}$ spins to the left.
5. Run down center of arena past end marker, execute a square sliding stop.
6. Complete $3\frac{1}{2}$ spins to the right.
7. Run down center of arena past center marker, execute a square sliding stop. Back at least 10 feet. Hesitate to complete pattern.
